NOMINATIONS FOR 2008 OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS OF GAHA

The Nominating Committee consists of those members of the GAHA Board of Directors whose 3-year terms are NOT expiring at the end of the present year. Traditionally, that committee meets and selects one name for each officer position and one name for each of the directors' slots that currently are expiring or, for some other reason, slots that need to be filled. This in no way precludes GAHA voting members from putting additional names on the ballot by nominating from the floor at our annual elections meeting. However, it is my opinion that this process is stifled by the fact that a list is presented as if it is a 'done deal' with only one name presented per position.

As Chairperson of the 2007 Nominating Committee, I would ask the membership to contact me with names of those members they would like to see on the ballot. I would prefer that the list that is presented to the membership by the Committee to contain more than one name for most positions. The GAHA members will be informed of the final list at least 45 days in advance of the election meeting to be held in January 2008. And those who cannot attend the election meeting will be given the opportunity to vote by proxy. And, again, I stress the fact that additional names can still come in as a result of floor nominations at the January 2008 meeting.

MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

If you are an adult GAHA member, or a GAHA Life Member and not linked to our club through AHA, (linked to another club or GAHA only), please consider doing so. The number of delegates that we send to convention is determined by this number. We have many members that have GAHA memberships and memberships with other clubs. You determine what club your delegate vote goes to when renewing your AHA membership. If you choose another club as your "home" club, that club is the one that can claim you for delegate counts and you are recognized by AHA as belonging to that club only. Only one club membership can be linked to one AHA membership. You can however purchase a second AHA membership to link with GAHA. The cost to link your GAHA membership to AHA is \$25. While duplicate AHA memberships may seem redundant, you will be helping our delegates represent GAHA with the strongest voice possible. Please let Kathy Hedgepeth know if you want to do this. She can handle all of the details for you.

We missed sending an extra delegate to Convention by 10 memberships this year. We don't want to let that happen again so we are initiating a membership drive for 2008. The person who accumulates the most points will have their 2008 AHA/GAHA dues WITH competition card paid by GAHA. They will also receive two bridle bags. The two runners up will also receive a bridle bag. A form was also sent along with the Directory package and one is posted here also that will give details on how this works. The Prize will be awarded at our 2008 Annual Meeting in January. Our Youth memberships are important to us too so we've included a little something for them too with the Membership Drive. Each current GAHA youth member that brings us a NEW youth member will receive a bridle bag too! Our goal is to get our total AHA/GAHA recognized membership to 251 or MORE! That is 58 more than we have now. That would give us a cushion, and get us 2 more delegates for 2008.

GAHA Amateur Futurity Rules

Arabian & Half-Arabian/Amateur Halter & Open Performance

*The mare must be nominated during the year she is bred (No Late nominations)	\$10.00
*Foal to be re-nominated the year it is born	\$20.00
Late Fee --- \$60.00 (\$20.00 Re-nomination + \$40.00 Late charge)	
*Yearlings to be re-nominated	\$30.00
Late Fee--- \$90.00 (\$30.00 Re-nomination + \$60.00 Late Charge)	
*Two- year olds to be re-nominated-	\$40.00
Late Fee----\$120.00 (40.00 Re-nomination + \$80.00 Late Charge)	
*Three-year olds to be re-nominated and shown at halter by AMATEUR OR OWNER for payback	\$50.00
Late Fee---\$150.00 (\$50.00 Re-nomination + \$100.00 Late Charge)	
*Four-year olds may be shown in performance by AMATEUR OR PROFESSIONAL for payback	\$0.00

All halter entries must be shown by an AMATEUR OR BY THE RECORDED OWNER. The 4 year old performance horses may be shown by an amateur or professional rider. The collected fees for each age group will remain separate (resulting in each year's payback being a different amount of money). Fillies, Colts, and Geldings are in separate futurities.

Only bred mares may be started in this futurity. Mare nomination must be received or postmarked by December 31 of the year in which she is bred. No post entries will be accepted.

POST ENTRIES: A re-nomination must be received each year for all colts, fillies & geldings. Foals may be re-instated to the program with payment of the regular annual re-nomination fee plus a late penalty of two times the regular fee for each year to be re-instated. All additional funds collected will go into the payback for the appropriate year.

PAYBACKS:

1. Breeding and weanling year nomination fees (\$10.00 & \$20.00): ½ to Three-year old payback, ½ to Four-year-old payback.
 2. Yearling and Two-year old re-nomination fees (\$30.00 & \$40.00): ½ to Three-year old payback, ½ to Four-year-old payback.
 3. Three-year old re-nomination fees (\$50.00): All funds go to Four-year-old Performance payback.
 4. Apportionment of payback: 1ST Place – 50%, 2nd Place – 20%, 3RD Place – 15%, 4TH Place – 10%, 5TH Place – 5%
- Nomination is transferred to new owner should a pregnant mare or foal be sold. New owner is responsible for nomination fees after that date.

Futurity classes are to be held at a GAHA show during the summer or fall. No class entry fees will be charged. Horses need not be shown prior to the fourth year to remain in the program. State residency is NOT required. Membership in the Georgia Arabian Horse Association IS required.

If a colt is gelded after being nominated and prior to the Futurity classes, the Futurity Chairman MUST BE NOTIFIED.

All mare nominations must be postmarked by December 31 or they WILL BE RETURNED.

All re-nomination must be postmarked by December 31 or they WILL BE CHARGED THE LATE FEE.
